Zones of Regulation

Lesson 2: Zones Bingo

GOALS

- Increase the client's emotional vocabulary
- Increase the client's ability to read facial expression
- Deepen the client's understanding of the Zones

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Bingo marks of some sort
- Paper cutter/scissors
- Bingo Cards
- Zones Emotions
- Container to put emotional card in

LEAD-IN

1. Facial Expression

- Have someone make dramatic facial expressions and ask the client to identify the emotions. This activity should continue until the client is unable to identify the emotion.
- 2. Facilitate a conversation about the importance of accurately reading the facial expressions of others.
- 3. Share the goals of the activities

BINGO ACTIVITY (Directions)

- Provide a description of the activity, including the goal for the bingo game.
- Call out the names of the emotions or show him or her the picture. Give the client time to find the accurate emotions as demonstrated by them putting a marker on the appropriate space.
- The game will continue until a bingo is called.

WRAPPING UP

- Follow up questions:
 - 1. What new emotions or facial expression did you learn?
 - 2. Can you demonstrate the new emotions or facial expression you have learned?
 - 3. Can you recognize what zone others are in based on his or her facial expressions?
 - 4. How could reading someone's facial expression change how you interact with them?
