I. Purpose

To outline the process for what the agency will accommodate each client's transportation needs and preferences.

II. Policy/Procedure

UCP of Maine will accommodate each residents' transportation needs and preferences. UCP of Maine regularly transports residents to day programs, medical appointments, counseling, job support, family visits, and any community outings they wish to attend. Other options of transportation are also available that are listed below.


Transportation is available **upon request** for travel within the Bangor/Brewer area. Transportation is also available for longer trips with a 48-hour notice. An example would be traveling 40 or more miles outside the Bangor/Brewer area. Transportation may be provided for longer trips without a 48-hour notice if transportation available at time of request.

Transportation is available during normal business hours. Adjustments to transportation availability can be requested in advance for travel outside of these hours.


If other residents have requested transportation, and vehicles are already in use, there may be times where a delay in transportation occurs.

Transportation will not be provided in conditions where it would be dangerous to travel (i.e. weather or any other unforeseen circumstances).

Other transportation options are available (attached) All modes of transportation are posted in the homes. Staff will assist as needed if any of these options are to be utilized, as well as assist with budgeting for transportation.
