**I. Purpose**

To define the requirement for conflict free membership for Board members as defined by the certification requirements in 14-197 CMR Chapter 10.

**II. Policy**

Board members for UCP must be conflict free. Board members may not be an employee of any state or federal government entity associated with the licensing of, purchase of service from or contracting with, or immediate family.

Board members complete a Conflict of Interest Statement annually to verify that no conflict of interest exists in their current function as a Board member of UCP.
